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DAY ONE

14 DAYS DISCIPLESHIP QUICK PROGRAM

WHO DO WE LISTEN TO AS JESUS DISCIPLES

BIBLE STUDY

Matthew 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him. 17:6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.

BACKGROUND

After Jesus spent about 3 years in ministry and after he had defeated all the temptations that the devil could bring his way, Jesus took his closest disciples up the mountain and he transfigured before them.

There were two men whose dead bodies weren't released by God in the old testament, one was Moses and the other ELIJAH who went up on chariots.

MESSAGE

On the mount of transfiguration, God brought the body of Moses to the mountain. Moses represented the Laws and the regime of laws. He didn't shine nor glow. He was brought to the mountain to stand as the representative of laws.

Another person brought to the mountain top was Elijah. The fiery prophet was brought in to represent the regime of the prophets. He stood for the times when God wouldn't speak to anyone except by his prophets. Elijah didn't glow or shine. He was just brought in to be with his God, Jesus.

Then we have Jesus on the mountain too. He was the only one who transfigured, He was glowing and shining.

This actually meant Jesus was the star of the moment.

THEN GOD SPOKE AUDIBLY FROM THE CLOUDS.

THIS IS MY BELOVED SON, IN WHOM I AM WELL PLEASED.

This gave us a clear indication of the fact that God had listened to all the instructions Jesus had given His disciples and He was pleased.

God has heard all the reprimand Jesus gave the elders in the synagogue and God was pleased

God heard those seemingly tough teachings of Jesus, God listened to everything Jesus did in about 3 years and God was pleased.

God being pleased with all Jesus did means God agrees that the Jesus way is the correct way.

THEN GOD SPOKE AUDIBLY FROM THE CLOUDS.

THIS IS MY BELOVED SON, IN WHOM I AM WELL PLEASED. HEAR YEE HIM

God Himself audibly gave the last audible instructions to men on the mount of transfiguration. He simply pointed Jesus as His Son and the only one we are to listen to.

God never said, these are my sons, in whom I am well pleased. No He didn't say that

God never said, hear Yee them.

God singled out Jesus as the only person we are to listen to.

In one scene, God removed the laws of Moses as our anchor.

At the same time, God deliberately used Elijah to represent all prophets, past and present. They were removed from being our anchor.

THE IMPLICATIONS OF THESE

Where Jesus says A, and Moses says A. We believe and follow Jesus and relate with the story of Moses

Where Jesus says A, and Moses says B. We believe and follow Jesus and we disregard Moses.

Where Jesus says A, and any prophet, Pastor, Apostle or man of God says A. We believe and follow Jesus and relate with the message of the human

Where Jesus says A, and any prophet, Pastor, Apostle or man of God says B. We believe and follow Jesus and disregard the message of the human

CONCLUSION

The last time God spoke audibly, it was to tell us that we are to only listen to Jesus and Jesus alone.

If you want to be a disciple of Jesus who wants to make it to heaven, you cannot take your instructions from anyone but from Jesus.

PS: The instructions Jesus gave us were given to unlearned men, that is, you don't need to visit a theological seminary or gain special skills before you can understand Jesus.

WHY OTHER PERSONS DON'T QUALIFY TO INSTRUCT US AS JESUS DISCIPLES

BIBLE VERSES

1 Corinthians 13:9 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. 13:10 But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.

Matthew 11:11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

Read Vs 3 to 14

Hebrews 8:7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. 8:8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Read Vs 9 to 11

BACKGROUND

Jesus in His teaching stated that John the Baptist is greater than all persons born in the old testament. The only major difference between John the Baptist and all

other prophets is that John the Baptist met with Jesus. This clearly let's us know that Jesus is the key to greatness

MAIN MESSAGE

Bro Paul stated in his letters to the Corinthians that he is only able to prophecy in part because he only knows in part.

Jesus on the other hand knows the full because He in the beginning and knows the ending.

It would be a great heresy to leave Jesus who knows full and base your instructions from a fellow man who only know in part.

Where bro Paul in his passion states things that could be given another meaning that might be subtly or greatly different from that of Jesus, we must stick to the meaning given to us by Jesus because he knows in full.

When Jesus stated that John the Baptist was greater than David, Elijah, Isaiah, Solomon and the rest, Jesus had confirmed what was written in Hebrews that, the processes and procedures of the old covenant was faulty thus there is need for a new covenant in Jesus.

We can't take our instructions from the old faulty processes that produced the imperfections of the old testament.

Examples

We can't base our lessons on how to pray from psalms. They are nice poetry and grants us insight into how the imperfections of the old testament works, but our new perfect instructions on prayer comes from Jesus who taught us how to pray.

We can't base our instructions on how to deal with our enemies from Elijah, he operated under the imperfections of the old testament, rather we learn from Jesus

We can't learn how to prophecy from Isaiah or the good old lamenter. Rather we learn from Jesus

Solomon though was a good wisdom to the guys who never met Jesus, but we that have access to Jesus have access to the wisdom of God.

Come let's really look at it, a man who marries 300 wife isn't wise at all.

CONCLUSION

The meaning of the Word CHRISTIAN is LIKE CHRIST. The only way to be like Christ is to learn from Christ.

The best way to learn Christ is to learn Christ from Christ directly.

Thank God that Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. You can learn from Him directly through His word. The Bible.

That is why in the past, some of the illiterates who gave their lives to Jesus were given special grace to read the Bible while they can't read other books. They can't write any letter but once they pick up the Bible, they can read it.

Pick the Bible today and learn directly from Jesus who knows in full and taught us in full.

We can't have the original readily available yet we would decide to study from a copy.

Jesus is the original template for Christianity. Jesus knows best how to be another Jesus on earth. Christ knows best what it really takes to be a Christian.

That is why you are called to be Christ and Christ alone disciple.

THE PLACE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN DISCIPLESHIP

BIBLE VERSES

Genesis 1:1-2

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters

Luke 1:35

35 The angel answered, “The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God

John 14:16-17

16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you

BACKGROUND

Genesis opened with God the father in verse 1, Holy Spirit in verse 2 and Jesus the word of God in verse 3. It is very important to note that the Holy Spirit wasn't an after thought but had been right there in the beginning

MAIN MESSAGE

Mary couldn't have been able to carry the seed of God in her without the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit had to overshadow her before she could carry the Holy seed.

Furthermore, in act 10:38 we can note that Jesus was able to do all He did as a man on earth by the power of the Holy Spirit.

This points us to the fact that you can't please the Holy God or carry the seed or fruit of the Holy God without the Holy Spirit.

In act 1:8, Jesus said we shall receive power after the Holy Spirit is come upon us.

In act 10:38, the power that Jesus received was so that He can have the character to do good.

In John 1:12 We were made to know that this power is to become the sons of God.

That is, the power that Jesus promised us, is the power to do good exactly like Jesus did

Healing the sick, raising the dead are manifestation of power, they are not the real power.

The first point of the power of the Holy Spirit is to make us to have the character of Jesus.

CHRISTIAN = CHRIST LIKE

The real meaning of Christian is a person that is like Christ. That is a carbon copy of Christ

Christ was able to do good, He had no sin and pleased the father because He was filled with the Holy Spirit while He was on earth.

The only way to also achieve the life of Jesus and to become exactly like Jesus is to receive help from the spirit that helped Jesus as a man.

The more you surrender your will to the teachings of the Holy Spirit, the more you become more like Jesus.

It is only when you become like Jesus that you become a Christian

HOLY SPIRIT BEFORE JESUS AND AFTER JESUS

As noted, the Holy Spirit had been available from creation but was only available to prophets, certain kings etc

But in act 2, the prophecy of, in the last days, I will pure out my Spirit upon all flesh..... Came to manifestation.

You no longer need to go through a priest or a prophet before you can access the Holy Spirit.

The spirit has been poured out to everyone who is ready to receive Him.

With God nothing shall be impossible, God can make you another Jesus carbon copy with the help of the Holy Spirit.

CONCLUSION

Jesus never said by their confessions yee shall know them. No!!!

Jesus said by their fruits yee shall know them. Fruits are your personalities and your works.

Without you allowing the Holy Spirit work on you, you will only be a person who is opposite of Christ. That is anti Christ.

If you go to church or follow a ministry or work in church or administer a church but you haven't been helped by the Holy Spirit to become exactly like Christ, you will only be church goers, church workers, church minister or church apostle but not a Christian.

The day you totally submit to the Holy spirit to perform the same work He did in Jesus by making you do good like Jesus, then you will produce fruits like Jesus. We can now call you a Christian.

There are many people filling auditoriums, others performing miracles but they are not yet Christians

Can you surrender your self today totally to the Holy Spirit

DAY FOUR

THE MEANING OF DISCIPLESHIP

PART ONE

BIBLE VERSES

Matthew 28:19–20

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

MEANING

A disciple has been shown to be someone who follows the teachings, life, and aim of another until the person becomes like the master.

Discipleship in the Christian sense is the process of making someone become like Christ. The disciple of Christ is to become like Christ in everything.

Discipleship is the process of being uprooted from your previous master, the devil and all his works and being grafted onto the vine, Jesus, pruned to bear specific kind of fruits as dictated by the vine

BACKGROUND

Jesus Christ, the beloved son of God, the word of God Himself, the only perfect man to have walked the earth, came to correct every error in our walk with God. He introduced Discipleship process.

The Discipleship process from Jesus had a 100% success. Judas was chosen intentionally because Jesus needed an internal person to betray Him.

When Jesus was finally going, He told His disciples to continue the process.

A successful process needs to be replicated.

MAIN MESSAGE

In the beginning, before any form of sin came into this world, Jesus started the first one on one fellowship with Adam and Eve in the garden.

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

This was the first Discipleship between Jesus and the first humans on earth but it didn't last long because the first humans pulled out when they sinned.

After sin broke the relationship between God and man, the process of discipleship became tampered with.

Rather the process of one priest with many congregants was adopted. At best we had sons of the prophets.

The set up of one on one Discipleship was reduced greatly but the few persons that still used the process, had serious successes.

Elijah disciplined Elisha and it was successful. Moses disciplined Joshua and it was successful.

Elisha was to disciple Gehazi but lust and sin broke that Discipleship program.

When God killed all those who didn't have faith in Him in the wilderness, only Joshua and Caleb who were learning under the Discipleship of Moses, escaped death.

The process of a priest and multiple congregation without the one on one Discipleship wasn't successful even till the time of Jesus.

Then Jesus came, to correct all the errors with the style of worship of the old testament and part of that was to introduce Himself the concept of discipleship.

Jesus chose 11 disciples and none of them fell by the way, none of them backslided.

Jesus chose 1 betrayer and he fulfilled his mandate.

Jesus had 100% success as against the huge failures of the huge congregational styles of worship in the old testament.

Having successfully completed this new process, Jesus specifically told His disciples to continue the process.

In Acts 1:8, Jesus was telling them that after they have been empowered, they are to look for others to disciple. First from around Jerusalem.

Those they disciple will also look for others to disciple. Till it spread to Samaria & to the uttermost part of the world

CONCLUSION

Paul taught the few willing people in Corinth for 2 solid years with a lot of one on one Discipleship.

After so much time learning Jesus, the unbelievers started calling Paul's little flocks "people like Jesus". This is the reason for the name Christian.

They started seeing every character of Jesus in these persons who had undergone discipleship properly.

The sure way to become like Jesus is through the Discipleship process as laid down by Jesus.

That you came out for altar call doesn't mean you are fully like Christ until you pass the Discipleship process duly.

The altar call is the first stage, discipleship is the main stage in your walk with God.

Being a worker, becoming a minister or being appointed a committee member in church or becoming a pastor still doesn't make you to become like Christ until you go through correct Discipleship

Going to Discipleship certificate school or the seminary doesn't make you a Christ until you pass through discipleship

This is where you work out your salvation with fear and trembling. This is the real great commission that Jesus gave to us, to disciple the nations.

The lack of discipleship is the reason we have multitude of churches, millions of church goers yet wickedness is on the increase world wide. The lack of appropriate Discipleship after the order of Jesus is what led to the desecrations and shameful displays and scandals on the church altars today.

In day 5, we would go deeper into what Discipleship really means taking all our information from Jesus Himself.

PART TWO

BIBLE VERSES

John 8:44

44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 15:5

“I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

BACKGROUND

DISCIPLESHIP is the process of copying the entire lifestyle of a person so that you can become that person eventually. In this case, Jesus is the person we are choosing to copy.

There are two types of discipleship, The devil's and Jesus's

MAIN MESSAGE

We were all born into sin and iniquity. We were exposed to the general character of the sinful world.

When you were a sinner, Satan was your master. You did his bidding by pleasing your fleshy desires. You were selfish and rooted in the ways and ideas of this world.

You were planted in Satan and the longer you spent not following Jesus the deeper your root in Satan.

Satan, the prince of this world disciplined you in sin. You were told you weren't handsome or beautiful until you do certain things

You were told if you don't compromise, the society won't celebrate you.

You were told that you need money to be successful. You were told when you have money, you will enjoy life by living expensive

All these lies and many more were result of satanic Discipleship that you have been exposed to for many years.

These lies from satanic Discipleship formed your ideology and your characters. They were the foundation of your value system and their pillars formed your personality.

They created very powerful structures and very visible foundation in your life.

Sometimes, the person's who taught us in Sunday school also erroneously passed their own satanic Discipleship ideas to us right there in church.

Unfortunately, all ideas, foundation and character the world system gave us are in enmity with God and they are mostly anti Christ.

The day you came out for altar call, you indicated your willingness to submit to Jesus, but as at that time, your Spirit was saved but your physical personality still remains the same.

Your eyes didn't change and it will still look at porn if it sees one

Your mouth didn't change, it will still curse others at the slightest provocation.

Your sexual organ didn't change, they will still be aroused by what arouses them.

The ideology, way of life and lies from the world system is still very evident in your life.

You will need to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, tearing down the various lies and lifestyle that was part of your old life.

When you gave your life to Jesus, you chose a new master, there is a need to cut you from the evil worldly Discipleship

It is a total life transformation. It is impossible for you to bear the fruits of Jesus while still attached to the lies of Satan.

CONCLUSION

There need to be a process of being cut off, a painful process of the axe, axing you off your previous experiences, cutting off your previous fellow branches in Satan, cutting off your previous source of ideas and lifestyle.

The process cannot be made painless, the process cannot be rushed, the process cannot happen in 1 week. It is a deliberate process where you are reconnected back with God, grafted onto the vine called Jesus, so that you can bear the kind of fruits that Jesus bears.

The errors with the church today is that, we came to the church with all the baggages from the old life, then covered it with religious covering.

We want to continue building godly things on our old foundation. We want to skip Discipleship and jump into working.

That is why all our works will be tried in fire in the last day, any work built on ideology from worldly Discipleship will be destroyed

You need to painfully break the old foundation through grace before building. The grace to do this can only be made available by Jesus.

Actually this grace was available that moment you gave your life to Jesus, but ignorance of the discipleship process makes many miss out that grace.

Grace doesn't cover sin, grace defeats sin. If you make up your mind today, you can access that grace for correct discipleship in Jesus

Your life can become a mirror of the life of Jesus.

This happens through correct discipleship

THE MEANING OF DISCIPLESHIP

PART THREE

BIBLE VERSE

Luke 14:26

“If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Revelation 3:15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. 3:16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

BACKGROUND

Human is made of three parts. The spirit, the soul and the body. The soul is the real you, the spirit came from God and it will return to Him, your body also known as your flesh has an expiry date, it will return to dust.

MAIN MESSAGE

When you feed your spirit & allow your spirit lead you, you are a Spirit led being, when you feed & satisfy your flesh and you allow your flesh dictate to you, you are a flesh led being.

The spirit and the flesh are enemies. The spirit thinks of things eternal while the flesh thinks of things that are earthly and vanity. They are always against one another.

When we were in sin, we were dead to the leading of the spirit but alive to the leading of our flesh.

When the flesh ask for food, we give it the best we can get, when it asks for sex, we don't care, we break rules to satisfy it. When it wants vanity, we give it. We didn't listen to the Spirit at all.

Then the day our soul was touched by the word of God, the resurrection power of salvation raised up the quiet, silent spirit of God in us and we became alive to the Spirit.

But despite the fact that our spirit came alive, the flesh is still alive also and had not been killed. It is still demanding for the things we used to give it before.

The soul which is you, must now choose whom to obey. The more you obey the Spirit, the more alive you are in the spirit, the more you die to the flesh.

The more you obey the flesh, the more alive you become to the flesh, the more you die to the spirit.

At the place of salvation, there is a struggle within our soul.

It is at this point that we should enter discipleship so that we are shown how to silence the flesh and be alive to the spirit.

Have you gone for a program and your spirit was awakened, you ran from sin, you started praying and reading your Bible but after a week, it all died down? It is because your spirit momentarily came alive but after a week of obeying the flesh, you silenced the spirit.

Today, the reason we have so much problems in the church is because we want to be spiritually alive and fleshly alive at the same time.

This is an abomination, God never designed human to be alive in both.

In Rev 3, God said he'll prefer you were cold dead to obeying the spirit, or you were hot alive obeying the Spirit, but being lukewarm, trying to please both the spirit and the flesh, is an abomination. God will spit such out on the judgement day.

When you come to Jesus, you are to leave every information you learnt in sin and start afresh with Jesus.

Jesus makes you a new creature, you are no longer a person who pleases flesh but a person that no longer cares about worldly possessions but a person who obeys the spirit and yearns for that which is eternal.

Luke 14:26

The world is not supposed to understand you and you cannot blend with them because you are now a different creature.

But because this is your first time being a new creature, you need Jesus to teach you afresh what it really means to be a person led by the spirit.

In Discipleship, you learn how to walk with God as a new creature. You are not to learn from a man or about a man, but you are to learn directly from Jesus.

The human being God uses, can only show you Jesus without any additions or subtractions.

CONCLUSION

Trying to please God and please self is actually an abomination unto God. You can't possess God and possess earth together. Let Jesus teach you what to do

DAY SEVEN

THE PLACE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN DISCIPLESHIP, QUESTION AND ANSWER

BIBLE VERSES

John 16:13

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

BACKGROUND

Jesus, after He had successfully completed His discipleship process, knew He would not be physically on ground to continue to administer discipleships. He promised the Holy Spirit will continue where He stopped

MAIN MESSAGE

If we are to really put discipleship in its proper perspective, we would note that God the Father, God the son and God the Holy Spirit are all involved in discipleship.

When the devil first came to really tempt Jesus for the records, Jesus replied that man shall not live by bread alone but the Word of God.

Jesus is the word of God, Jesus is the person we are to live by.

But Jesus Himself told us that He didn't speak unless God the Father commanded him to speak.

John 12:49

For I did not speak on my own, but the Father who sent me commanded me to say all that I have spoken.

This means every word that Jesus spoke for our discipleship was actually commanded by the Father. Every instructions from Jesus had the signature of the unchangeable Father.

Jesus now went further to explain to us that the Holy Spirit whom will fill the earth after Jesus had gone, will not say anything new, rather he will only confirm what Jesus had said as commanded by the Father.

So in your walk with God today, you are being guided by the Holy Spirit who doesn't have any new information or instructions. Rather the Holy Spirit will only explain to you how to apply the instructions from Jesus that God the Father commanded.

This is very key because in this age, a lot of persons claim that they have fresh information and updated instructions from the Holy Spirit. This is very opposite to what Jesus said about the Holy Spirit.

I here a lot saying that prosperity is the way to heaven, Jesus never said that and the Holy Spirit can never create a prosperity apostle.

Some say poverty is the way to heaven, Jesus never said that and the Holy Spirit can't ask you to say that

I have heard ministers claiming the Holy Spirit told them to divorce, that's impossible because Jesus expressly stated that it was not allowed.

I have heard ministers saying the Holy Spirit told them that homosexuality is ok, but that can never be the Holy Spirit because Jesus expressly stated that marriage is between man and woman.

These are many more examples clearly shows us that, the Holy Spirit will NEVER tell you to do something different from what Jesus said.

The duty of the Holy Spirit is to teach you further and deeper what God had spoken through Jesus.

CONCLUSION

The Holy Spirit doesn't have 21st century interpretations, The Holy Spirit is an integral part of the God head Trinity. It is impossible for one part of the Trinity to speak against the other part of the Trinity. They are one in all things.

This is why it is very important that you study and keep to heart every instructions from Jesus before listening to any human speaking. So that in places where the human being makes errors, you could discern that the Holy Spirit isn't the one speaking.

QUESTION ONE

Good afternoon my brother the day five on discipleship teaching was saying in my view that discipleship of Jesus Christ came to do away with the church structure so that we produce genuine believers. My question is why are we still having

church instead of discipleship grouping which can be multiplying more rapidly and producing mature believers

ANSWER

Jesus came to teach us that there is a better structure to help grow one another than the traditional church structure.

Jesus didn't totally do away with the church structure but He introduced a stronger system of raising citizens for heaven.

What we are supposed to be doing is to raise disciples even as we are planting churches.

Discipleship should be the main focus of the church and not attendance or offering or tithe.

The church shouldn't be concerned about how many branches they now have but be concerned about how deep each disciples are in Christ before looking for other disciples.

Unfortunately the church system had totally gone back to the old testament methods of prophets and apostles and pastors rather than focusing on the Jesus style of discipleship.

Our duty here is not to condemn any church but to open your own eyes so that you can become a disciple of Jesus and after you have grown, you will look for others to help disciple for Christ.

QUESTION

As Christian disciples, can we get angry or should be just be angry for a few minutes and get over it

ANSWERS

This is one of the places where we follow Jesus rather than bro Paul.

Jesus says you can't get angry until the person have offended you 70 and 7 times in one day.

Bro Paul said, get angry but sin not. But the moment you get angry, you have sinned because Jesus said you can only get angry when the person did the same thing over 70 times in one day. We all know that is usually impossible.

I have met men and women who through God had lost their ability to get angry, they so much easily forgive that you begin to wonder if they still have human emotions.

This is the level where God wants to take us to, a place where we would easily forgive fellow human so that we too can access forgiveness.

We should desire the grace to totally overcome anger. Anger rest in bossom of fools.

DAY EIGHT

TALE OF TWO DISCIPLES

BIBLE VERSES

Luke 5:11 And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him.

John 12:6

This He (Judas) said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

John 6:68

68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

Matthew 26:14-16

Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests, And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

BACKGROUND

Jesus had 12 disciples broken down into 11 true disciples and 1 betrayer. The 11 disciples chosen by Jesus were an example unto us of how to follow Jesus, either you are gifted and popular like Peter, James and John or you are silent like Bartholomew or weak like Thomas. There is a place for you

The one betrayer was an example for us, giving us a glimpse of how not to follow Jesus.

MAIN MESSAGE

Luke 5:12 gave us a glimpse of the type of disciple Peter was. He just received a great miracle from Jesus. A huge prosperity breakthrough as a fisher man. We would have expected him to hastily thank Jesus then go to his shop to sell the fishes and start sharing testimonies of how Jesus made him rich. It would have made business sense for Peter to give Jesus a weekly appointment to use his boat for preaching so that he can harvest weekly net breaking catch..

Peter never did any of these, rather Peter fell in love with Jesus and loved Jesus above all things. He left it all to follow Jesus. He prefer the giver than the gift.

Judas Iscariot was the opposite, in John 12, we saw Judas stealing from the purse of Jesus. He wasn't a follower because he loved Jesus, he was a follower because of what he can get from Jesus.

Check yourself, why are you following Jesus. Is it because you have learnt so much about Jesus that you now love him, or is it because you want a miracle?

Why did you give to that ministry or sow to that man of God, is it because you loved Jesus or because of your selfish need for kingdom investment returns?

Furthermore, in John 6:68, Peter told the Lord Jesus, He has no where to go, He had left everything to follow Jesus. His hope is only in Jesus, he had no backup plan. He was ready to swim or sink with Jesus.

Judas on the other hand still had relationships with the chief priest, an enemy of Jesus. Judas still had links to the office of the killers of Jesus.

Can you check yourself, are you ready to be a disciple like Peter or are you currently towing the line of Judas.

Why are you in ministry, is it because you have seen pastors with private jets or because you want to please Jesus no matter the circumstances.

Why are you in that ministry, is it because you loved Jesus so much and Jesus was the one that directed you there or are you there because you wanted to benefit from the Anointing of the leader?

Have you broken all those your sinful relationships of the past or are you still having a backup plan, should in case Jesus fail your expectations.

The day the devil came for both Peter and Judas in Luke 22, Jesus prayed for His disciple Peter. Jesus defended Peter from the evil plans the devil had for him.

But Jesus gave Judas the Holy Communion so that he can receive strength to do the betrayal he had in mind. Judas went by that Anointing to successfully betrayed Jesus.

We need to be very careful who you follow, some ministers have betrayed Jesus for fame, wealth and position, yet they will be very successful in whatever they do.

CONCLUSION

There are two kinds of followers, the disciples who won't question Jesus because they have left all to follow Jesus. On the other hand we have betrayers, they call Jesus and identify with Jesus when it is convenient but they are only after the worldly goods, prosperity, breakthrough, healing and miracles they can get from Jesus.

PRACTICAL DISCIPLESHIP

BIBLE VERSES

Matthew 13:36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

Acts 11:25 Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul: 11:26 And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.

Acts 18:8-11

BACKGROUND

One of the key questions in our hearts would be, How do we do discipleship in our own time and generation. In the days of Jesus, they had a different kind of lifestyle, it was not as civilised and hectic like ours. We trust God to help us to understand discipleship practical process today

MAIN MESSAGE

In today's churchly setting, we have ministers who comes to teach us about God but whom we know little about their own private lives.

Some of us had moved closer to some men of God only to discover that they are entirely different from what they portrayed on the pulpit.

This is because, the current style prevalent in many churches is "do what I teach" there is no provision for "do what I do practically". We really have little information about who they really are in their homes and thus they can't influence us right.

While we have the Holy Spirit as our major guide, we sometimes need a human being like us who is currently fulfilling all the requirements from Jesus. This person will help our faith that following Jesus and Jesus alone is possible.

This is exactly how Jesus did it in His days, He lived with the disciples to the extent that the disciples learnt so much from Him informally. He influenced them with His daily lifestyle.

When Paul came to live with them in Antioch, He was in their midst, living the correct lifestyle till they all were strengthened by his own example to follow Jesus the correct way.

You cannot rely on altar messages alone, you need God Himself to guide you to a person easily accessible who can show you that obeying Jesus is very possible, this will encourage you to follow Jesus.

PLEASE NOTE, YOU ARE NOT TAKING INSTRUCTIONS FROM THIS PERSON, YOU WILL BE TAKING YOUR INSTRUCTIONS STRICTLY FROM JESUS. THIS PERSON WHO GOD WILL LEAD YOU TO, MUST BE FOLLOWING JESUS TOTALLY AND ALSO TAKING ALL INSTRUCTIONS FROM JESUS.

This person isn't a spiritual father or mother. Actually God is the only authorised spiritual father we know.

Usually, these persons are not loud, they have not been indoctrinated into denominational abyss. They are usually not celebrity brethren.

By now, I guess you are believing it will be impossible to see one.

Actually we have a few that God had planted in various cities of the world. I agree they seem scarce among the multitude of normal church goers.

Just as the narrow way to heaven is hidden and only a few will find it, those who are currently walking on the narrow way a very few and you can only find them by God's leading.

PRACTICAL PROCESS

The practical way discipleship is done today is by first allowing God to direct you to that person.

Then you test the person by coming to live with the person for few weeks to discover if the person truly abides by all Jesus instructed us. Usually you will spend days with that person with your spouse and children.

YES THIS SEEMS STRANGE TO YOU BECAUSE YOU ARE USED TO THE CURRENT NON DISCIPLESHIP CHRISTIANITY.

Usually, those who God had broken down the power of flesh in their lives, operates open door policy. Their homes are open to all the God sends for discipleship.

They won't collect a dime from you nor ask you to sow seed. Freely God taught them freely they will help you with your walk with God.

Over the course of 2 to 3 years, you will discover that those weaknesses that you thought no one can overcome, will be defeated in your life.

You will discover you can stay perfectly without any sin. Etc

You will see men and women who don't get angry no matter the issue, you will see brethren that can never lie, you will meet women who are totally submissive.

They are so humble that they will treat you as if you are more superior than they are, none of them will act like a spiritual father or mother, rather they will treat you with all love. They will share all that they have with you as if there is no tomorrow and they only rely on Jesus as their final authority and source on all matters.

This will help you to see that the instructions of Jesus Christ are not impossible. This will help you to see that Christian perfection is possible. This will help you walk with God and ultimately prepare you for rapture.

This is the practical Discipleship as laid down by Jesus.

BIBLE VERSES

Matthew 24:44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh. 24:45 Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season? 24:46 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. 24:47 Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods. 24:48 But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; 24:49 And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; 24:50 The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, 24:51 And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Ephesians 5:27

27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

BACKGROUND

Jesus had continually stated that he will come at a time we least expected Him. With all the issues of life how prepared are you for His unannounced coming.

Discipleship helps us to be ready at all times.

MAIN MESSAGE

Many of us have heard the phrase "no one is holy" or the phrase "no one can obey God fully, except by mercy".

These are phrases that never came out of the mouth of our lord Jesus Christ while He was teaching us.

Rather He challenges us to live above error and faults. He admonishes us to be very well prepared because He will not take any excuse whatsoever from us.

Jesus never stated that there is a chance for a second chance after death, He never promised to break His rules for anyone.

Rather in His parables, Jesus presented Himself as a tough judge who expects His subjects to be without spot or wrinkles.

The Holy Spirit that helped Jesus never to commit any sin is exactly the Holy Spirit that Jesus sent to help us.

If the Holy Spirit is powerfully enough to help Jesus never to sin, then Jesus already sent us the help that can assist us not to sin.

If Jesus said we would do greater works than He did, then Jesus is expecting us to even live a more holy life than He did.

Those phrases that gives you comfort that everyone is continuing in sin is actually very opposite to the expectations of Jesus.

The reason why you believe everyone is sinning is simple. You can be found in a congregation of sinners.

When you allow the Holy Spirit, lead you to a very few persons on the narrow way to heaven, you will discover that there are still human beings, who God has given the grace to overcome sin totally.

In Discipleship, God leads you to such persons and their upright walk with God encourages you too to become bold enough to ask God for the grace to overcome sin.

Their examples which is synonymous with biblical examples will help you convert Bible stories into your own personal experiences with God.

You will no longer view God as an invisible being but you will see God in your daily living.

Your experience of heaven will not start when you die, but as soon as you become a disciple of Jesus, your appetite for this world ends and your daily experience will be heaven on earth.

The world will despise you because you are no longer their own, even churches will disown you but you would have gain your place as a citizen of heaven.

CONCLUSION

If you are not intentionally preparing for eternity every minute of your life, then you are not prepared at all.

If the thought of eternity comes to you once a while or only during sermons, you are still not prepared.

If the cares of this world still hold a strong place in your heart, then you are not yet a citizen of heaven

If this world hadn't rejected you or started persecuting you, you are not yet fully prepared for eternity

Discipleship changes your focus, helps you obey all the commandments of Jesus which prepares you for eternity

DAY ELEVEN

THOSE EXCLUDED FROM DISCIPLESHIP

BIBLE VERSES

Luke 9:23

23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

John 21:3

3 Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.

Matthew 7:15-20

15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

16 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles

BACKGROUND

As wonderful and as life enriching as discipleship is, it's not actually everyone that qualifies to become a disciple or be used of God to disciple others for Jesus.

Those exempted are the proud in heart.

God hates the proud. The proud cannot be humble enough to follow diligently after the teachings of Jesus.

MAIN MESSAGE

Discipleship is a process where we follow Jesus and Jesus alone.

Anyone who wants to help others to follow Jesus must be following Jesus too.

If anyone isn't totally following Jesus, such a person isn't qualified to show you the way to Jesus.

You can't give what you don't have, if a person isn't 100% following Jesus, such a person can never lead you to follow Jesus properly.

Anyone who gives excuses for sin isn't following Jesus 100%.

Please it is important to note that having anointing is entirely different from following Jesus 100%

Jesus told us that many will do great miracles in His name but He doesn't know them as followers.

That a person displays anointing or performs miracles doesn't mean such a person follows Jesus.

It's also important to note that, that a person followed Jesus yesterday doesn't mean they are following Jesus today.

Peter was following Jesus, but he backslided temporarily and went back to fishing, all the disciples believed Peter must be right because Peter was close to Jesus. The followed him to fish and suffered wasted efforts.

If you take your gaze off Jesus and start following human being because they followed Jesus yesterday, you might end up with wasted life in hell.

FLEE FROM THESE TEACHERS

1. Those who have broken some commandments but instead of repenting, they use Bible verses to cover up.
2. Those who claim God gave them instructions that contravene Jesus instructions
3. Those who live a very unnecessary opulent lifestyle, they have made this world their home, they can't adequately prepare you for heaven.
4. Those who are always speaking about how God performed miracle through their shoes, chairs, cars, handkerchief etc, they will take your gaze off Jesus and make you believe in their anointing.
5. Those who are from one scandal to another, they are yet to be matured themselves.

These and many more, who flagrantly disobey Jesus cannot teach you about Jesus.

About 2000 years ago, bro Jude said that some had crept in unawares, to turn the grace of our God into lasciviousness. Today, after over 2,000 years, they are no longer creeping in, they are matching and dancing in, they are now church founders and senior ministers.

You have to run your Christian race very intentionally. Your soul is worth more than all the riches on earth. You can't afford to just follow anyone without first ensuring that the Holy Spirit guides you carefully.

CONCLUSION

If you follow a man because he is anointed or because he is charismatic, it might become the case of the blind, leading the blind.

It's better to spend a long time asking God who you should go to than you allow your senses and your eyes lead you to the wrong person.

Jesus warned us that even the very elect will be deceived by false teachings and erroneous doctrines.

The only hope for your soul is, first seek Jesus, study HIS INSTRUCTIONS and surrender to the Holy Spirit.

Become humble, drop behind all your titles, certificate and years in church. Leave behind your theological theories.

Forget all your past achievements and stories, they might become stubbing blocks in your future.

Come to Christ again like a child. Start afresh with Him.

DISCIPLESHIP OR NOTHING

BIBLE VERSES

Luke 19:1-10

And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho. And, behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich. And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature. And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycomore tree to see him: for he was to pass that way. And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house. And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully. And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord: Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

Luke 17:10 So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.

Matthew 19:21

Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

BACKGROUND

The encounter of Zacchaeus gave us an insight into how Jesus teaches and affects lives in His days.

Zacchaeus knew that just calling Jesus name won't work unless He obeys the teachings of Jesus, in order to please Jesus, He restituted his ways

Zacchaeus knew that Jesus was more interested in his giving to the poor than neglecting the poor to give to the ministry, so Zacchaeus gave to the poor.

Zacchaeus chose to be a disciple rather than just have dinner with Jesus

MAIN MESSAGE

If all that Jesus came to do was to die for our sins, He doesn't need to have disciples, He would just live alone. One week is enough to annoy those that will crucify Him.

He chose disciples because CHRIST discipleship is the WAY, He spent 3.5 years teaching because CHRIST teaching is the TRUTH and then died on the cross because CHRIST BLOOD released LIFE to us.

You can't jump the Discipleship way and the truth instructions and suddenly reap life. No!

You must go through the entire process correctly. That is the way Jesus left to us as an example.

Jesus was going to visit Zacchaeus but Salvation didn't come to Zacchaeus until He followed the teachings of Jesus.

Bro Paul too followed this same process of discipleship, he wasn't in the business of creating parishes and having a kingdom empire. Rather he invested much time in discipleship. He could spend one year at just a place teaching and showing examples before he moved to another place.

After he had left the new disciples, he will still patiently read all their letters and respond to them painstakingly. Those letters he used in discipleship are the ones we are reading today. Each letter was directed at certain happenings among budding disciples.

He only chose those who are very well disciplined as leaders and despite that, he still follows them up. An example is Timothy. Quality was more important than quantity for the early Christians.

In Luke 17:10, Jesus States that, when you do what you were asked to do, you are an unprofitable servant, you simply did what was required of you.

If a servant is asked to harvest 15 farms and he did the 15 farms, Jesus says that servant is unprofitable because he didn't do more than he was asked to do.

Isn't this a shock to us, we had thought once we do the barest minimum, God will reward us with so much. We had thought God doesn't even require so much from us. But this verse opens our eyes.

Jesus is saying, if you only obey ALL HIS INSTRUCTIONS, you are an unprofitable servant. You only become profitable when you do MORE THAN HIS INSTRUCTIONS.

We live in a time when many church goers and many church leaders don't even measure up to the barest minimum of Jesus's instructions. We live in a time when many persons only try to fulfil denominational doctrines which are usually lower than Jesus's instructions.

If the persons who fully obey Jesus are considered unprofitable, then many in this generation aren't even yet up to the level of a servant before God.

We are currently celebrating many people on earth who heaven doesn't even recognize. We are receiving awards for many services that isn't qualified when compared with the standards of Jesus.

Imagine a wealthy man feeding 1 million persons a month. We would celebrate such. But if heaven had given such a person grace to do more, such person has no reward in heaven for falling below the minimum expectations of heaven.

Some of us feel we are doing well because we compare ourselves to those around us, but if we are to compare ourselves to Jesus's standards, we would fall very short.

In order to measure up to the standards of Jesus, we need to undergo discipleship, the process of killing the flesh and following Jesus totally. It is in following the TRUTH in Jesus that the TRUE standards will be met via HIS grace released into you.

Even after you have met Jesus's standards, you are still unprofitable until you go an extra mile.

CONCLUSION

Isn't it time to stop wasting time hailing others who you don't know what standard of achievement God actually gave them and they are yet to fulfil

Wouldn't you face your own race squarely.

Wouldn't you stop following the church doctrines and papa teachings but rather focus your time on JESUS. Trust God to give you the grace not only to meet JESUS standards but going extra miles to be profitable for Jesus

If you are yet to become a disciple, all your givings, church work, sacrifices would just be a memorial like the centurion in book of Acts.

All your church certificates and ministerial positions are just mere mortal things that will expire at your death.

Your time on earth will only become relevant when you become a disciple of Jesus.

ADVANTAGES OF DISCIPLESHIP

BIBLE VERSES

Matthew 18:1 At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven? 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

Mark 10:28 Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee. 10:29 And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, 10:30 But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

Matthew 6:24

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other, Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

BACKGROUND

If the way to the cross that Jesus came to show us is the way of discipleship, then the God who loved us above all must have hidden treasures in discipleship.

They are so much, but let's just talk about a few

MAIN MESSAGE

Find below some advantages of discipleship

ONE ON ONE ATTENTION

The crowd and general congregants didn't have a one on one meeting with Jesus. They only had a long range relationship. This is why today in the church, a lot rely on their pastors because they can't go personally to God themselves.

It's the opposite for disciples, they have direct access to Jesus. He intentionally creates avenue to have discussions with him. They don't need to go through a prophet or a spiritual assistant. They are the heartbeat of the master

DEEPER MYSTERIES

Jesus spoke to the crowd in parables. Despite the fact that He loved the world, He was more concerned about the disciples than the crowd who can't be saved by parables. He left the crowd with parables that made them more confused.

But in the secret fellowship with disciples, He speaks clearly and deeply. The mysteries of the kingdom can't be gotten in a church service, it comes to disciples in their fellowship with Jesus

LABOUR OVER YOUR SOUL

In the time of Jesus, people were dying, souls were perishing but Jesus didn't rush His ministry for the general congregation. Rather He kept labouring on the very few disciples that come to him according to His instructions

This is in contrast to what we have today, we are rushing to create more parishes, more churches and more auditorium, but we neglected discipleship, the heartbeat of Jesus.

100% ANSWERS TO PRAYERS

In Matthew 18 Jesus told the disciples that whatever they decree on earth will be established in heaven. Please note, Jesus wasn't speaking to the crowd again in this verse, He directed His speech to just the disciples.

One key reasons the disciples have answers to Prayers is because they won't ask for anything that is not the will of God

They are not asking amiss, they aren't asking to please flesh or to show off, they won't ask for anything that God hasn't given them the permission to ask.

Since they are subjected to the total will of the father, they do not ask outside His will

GOD'S PRESENCE

Jesus visited the crowd once a while, they see miracles and signs and wonders once a while but the disciples lived and will always live with Jesus.

The disciples enjoyed the presence of Jesus and that is why their lives were full of joy.

REGAIN LOST THINGS

No one gives anything to Jesus that won't reap it both on earth and in heaven. Jesus isn't just a receiver, He is the giver. When you let go anything for Jesus, He will repay you, not in your own way but in heaven divine way.

ETERNAL LIFE

Many good things on earth are miniatures of what is available in heaven. The best treasures on earth are like dust in heaven.

When Jesus promised that he wanted to prepare a place for us in heaven, he was talking about a home only for His disciples. He wasn't speaking to the crowd.

Others might be homeless after death but disciples already got a promise from Jesus that there is a home after earth.

BIBLE VERSES

John 21:19 This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. 21:20 Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? 21:21 Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? 21:22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

Luke 9:23

23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

Jesus wants to reach more people, the current church setting only creates religious persons without personal relationship with Jesus.

Could you today become the link that God will use to break religious Christianity in your environment?

Today Jesus is not calling you to another religious exercise but He is calling you to come to follow him.

He is asking you to deny yourself, pick up your cross today and follow him

If you have decided to follow Jesus, to leave the lies of the devil and the vanishing vanity that the devil is using to enslave others, then can I ask you to stand up wherever you are, raise up your right hand and say the following prayers with me
